How safe is it for our kids to roam the internet and interact with people they don't know? In recent years the Internet has become a platform for political debates and freedom of expression. The lack of control can be seen as positive and negative depending on the audience and the purpose of use. The workshop will address some of these issues; and while it might not be able to answer all the above questions, the workshop will provide the platform for discussion and debate of these vital issues.

- **Sergeant Tim Stadler, Tulsa Police Force**
